AN ACT
RELATI NG TO MDTOR VEHI CLES; CHANG NG CRI TERI A REGARDI NG USE OF SAFETY BELTS AND CHI LD PASSENGER RESTRAI NTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEG SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. Section 66-7-369 NMSA 1978 (bei ng Laws 1983, Chapter 252, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:
" 66-7-369. CHI LD PASSENGER RESTRAI NT- - ENFORCEMENT. - -
A. [ Ne] $\underline{A}$ person shall not oper ate a passenger car, van or pi ckup truck in this state [and not], except for an authorized emergency vehicle, publ ic transportation or a school bus, unl ess [each passenger under eleven] all passengers less than ei ght een years of age [ís] are properly restrai ned.

## B. Each person less than ei ghteen years of age

 shall be properly secured in a child passenger restraint . 136539. 1device or by a safety belt, unless all seating positions equi pped with safety belts are occupied, as follows:
(1) children less than one year of age shal I be properly secured in a rear-facing child passenger restraint devi ce [ Which meets the standards prescribed in 49 CFR 571.213] that meets federal standards, in the rear seat of the vehicle or in the front seat of the vehicle if the passengersi de ai $r$ bag is deacti vated;
(2) children one year of age [and older but Hess than five] through four years of age, regardless of wei ght, or children who wei gh less than forty pounds, regardless of age, shall be properly secured in a child passenger restrai nt device [ wich meets the standards prescribed in 49 CFR 571.213 or in the rear seat by a safety belt provided in the notor vehicle; and] that meets federal st andar ds;
(3) children five years of age [and older but tess than eleven years of age shall be-secured by a-safety belt provided in the not or vehicle in ei ther the front or rear seat] through twel ve years of age shall be secured by a seat belt in the rear seat of a motor vehicle equi pped with a rear seat, unl ess all available seating positions are occupi ed by passengers $t$ wel ve years of age or younger; and
(4) chil dren thirteen through sevent een years of age shall be secured by a safety belt in the front seat or . 136539. 1
rear seat of the vehi cle.
[B.] C. Failure to be secured by a child passenger restraint device or by a safety belt as required by this section shall not in any instance constitute fault or negligence and shall not limit or apportion damages." Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provi sions of this act is July 1, 2001.
