RELATI NG TO THE PUBLI C PEACE, HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE; RELATI NG TO THE STATE J UDI CI AL SYSTEM CREATI NG THE STATE J UDI CI AL SYSTEM STUDY COMM TTEE; PROVI DI NG DUTI ES AND POWERS; MAKI NG AN APPROPRI ATI ON; DECLARI NG AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGI SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. STATE J UDI CI AL SYSTEM STUDY COMM TTEE CREATED. - The joint interimlegi slative "state judicial system st udy committee" is created. The committee shall function from the date of its appoi ntment until Decenber 1 prior to the first session of the forty-sixth legislat ure.

Section 2. MEMBERSH P- - APPO NTMENT- - VACANCI ES. --
A. The state judicial system study committee shal I be composed of ten menbers appoi nted by the New Mexi co legislative council. Five menbers shall be appointed fromthe . 138001. 1

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house of representatives and five members fromthe senate. At the time of appointment, the legi slative council shall desi gnate the chai rman and vi ce chai rman of the committee.
B. Menbers shall be appoi nted from each house so as to give the two maj or political parties in each house the same proportionate representation on the committee as prevails in each house; however, in no event shall either party have Iess than one member fromeach house on the state judicial systemstudy committee. At the request of the committee chai rman, members may be removed from the committee by the New Mexi co legi slative council for nonattendance in accordance with council policy. Vacanci es on the committee may be filled by the New Mexi co legislative council, or the council may reduce the size of the committee by not making repl acement appoi nt ments and in that case need not readj ust party represent at ion.
C. An action shall not be taken by the committee if a maj ority of the total menbership fromeither house on the committee rejects that action.

Section 3. DUTI ES AND PONERS. --
A. After its appoi ntment, the state judi cial systemstudy committee shall hol d an initial meeting to devel op a work pl an and budget for the ensuing interim The work pl an and budget shall be submitted to the New Mexi co I egi slative council for approval. Upon approval of the work . 138001. 1
pl an and budget by the New Mexi co legi slative council, the committee, in cooper ation with the members of the state judi ci ary, shall:
(1) examine the stat utes, constitutional provi sions, regul ations and court deci si ons governing the judicial systemin New Mexico;
(2) eval uate the effectiveness of the judi ci ary system and
(3) make recommendations to the legi sl at ure rel ating to new legislation or changes in current law, if any, determined necessary by the committee.
B. Any nember of the committee nay administer oaths. The committee or a subcommittee ther eof may have the power of subpoena, whi ch may be enf orced through any di strict court of the state. Process of the committee shall be served by any sheriff, deputy or member of the state police, and shall be served without cost to the committee.

Section 4. REPORT. - - The state judi ci al system study committee shal make a report of its findings and recomendations for the consideration of the first sessi on the forty-sixth legislature. The report and suggested Iegislation shall be made available to the legislative council on or before December 15 preceding that session.

Section 5. APPROPRI ATI ON.--Fifty thousand dollars ( $\$ 50,000$ ) is appropriated fromthe general fund to the . 138001. 1
legislative council service for expenditure in fiscal years 2002 and 2003 for the purpose of paying the sal aries and expenses of the technical, legal and clerical staff and for rei mbursing the per di em and mileage expenses of the state judicial system study committee. Any unexpended or unencumbered bal ance remai ning at the end of fiscal year 2003 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 6. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, heal $t h$ and safet $y$ that this act take effect i medi at el $y$.
