## Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 571 appropriates $\$ 400,000$ from the general fund to the Human Services Department for the purpose of contracting with a statewide food bank program to gather, pack, transport, distribute and prepare unsaleable and surplus fresh produce to feed hungry and homeless New Mexicans.

## FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of $\$ 400.0$ contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the General Fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of Fiscal Year 2002 shall revert to the General Fund.

## ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS

None known. The appropriation is to the Human Services Department. The department has not responded to a request for a bill analysis. The request was made on 2-6-2001.
