## **SUMMARY**

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Joint Resolution 10 proposes a constitutional amendment to update the voting age and to delete the prohibitions against "idiots and insane persons" exercising the right to vote.

# FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The joint resolution does not contain an appropriation. The Secretary of State indicates a cost of \$30.0 relating to the printing, advertising and translation of proposed constitutional amendments. This cost is absorbed in the agency's operating budget.

# **TECHNICAL ISSUES**

Section 1-4-26 NMSA 1978 provides that an individual who is determined to be legally insane shall have their voter registration cancelled. This statute would conflict with the proposed constitutional amendment.
