## SUMMARY

Synopsis of SRC Amendment

The Senate Rules Committee amendment to Senate Bill 16 changes the proposed maximum compensation for members of precinct boards to \$150.00/election day.

#### Synopsis of Original Bill

Senate Bill 16 increases the maximum compensation for members of precinct boards, from \$7.00/hr to \$125.00/election day.

## Significant Issues

According to the agency, recruitment of precinct board members is difficult and an increase in compensation will help their recruitment efforts.

# FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There is no appropriation contained within the bill. Passage of the bill would increase election costs to the local governments because of the higher compensation; however, the impact can be absorb within existing resources.
