SUMMARY

Synopsis of SIAC [Senate Indian Affairs Committee] Amendment

The amendment changes style and adds the Indian Health Services as a cooperating agency.

Synopsis of Original Bill

SB 140 appropriates \$25,000 to the Agency on Aging for the development of a statewide prescription drug discount program. This is intended to help establish a Native American prescription drug bulk funding program.

Significant Issues

Native American tribes use their purchasing power to negotiate for discounted prices on prescription drugs, and there may be a potential to increase this purchasing power with additional participants. The bill contains an emergency clause.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

\$25.0 from the general fund is appropriated to State Agency on Aging. There is an emergency clause so that the funds can be spent in FY01 and FY02.
