A JOINT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING TO SELL LA VILLA RIVERA, MARIAN HALL AND CATHEDRAL PARK IN SANTA FE IN SANTA FE COUNTY.

WHEREAS, Section 13-6-3 NMSA 1978 requires ratification and approval of any sale of real property by a state agency for a consideration of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) or more; and

WHEREAS, the property control division of the general services department is desirous of selling real property and improvements, legal description set forth below; and

WHEREAS, the property control division proposes to sell La Villa Rivera, Marian hall and Cathedral park in Santa Fe county, New Mexico and more particularly described as:

Beginning at a point marked by a 1/2" rebar on the southerly side of East Palace Avenue, whence the

center of manhole cover No. W3-16 at the 1 2 intersection of Cathedral Place and East Palace Avenue bears N. 59° 42' W., 56.44 feet; thence, 3 from said point of beginning, along the southerly 4 side of East Palace Avenue S. 73° 36' E., 799.25 feet to a point marked by an "X" mark on sidewalk, 7 whence the center of manhole cover No. W3-21 at the intersection of East Palace Avenue and South 8 9 Castillo Avenue bears N. 72° 39' E., 62.21 feet; 10 thence on a curve to the right, R = 24.70 feet, 11 through an arc length of 34.37 feet to a point 12 marked by a 1/2" galvanized iron pipe, the chord of said arc running S. 34° 22′ E., 31.66 feet; thence 13 14 along the westerly side of South Castillo Avenue, S. 06° 08' W., 200.05 feet to a point marked by a 15 3/4" galvanized iron pipe, whence the center of 16 17 manhole cover No. W4-2 bears N. 47° 05.9' E., 21.18 feet; thence along the westerly side of South 18 19 Castillo Avenue S. 05° 16′ W., 198.20 feet to a 20 point marked by a 3/8" rebar, whence the center of 21 sanitary sewer manhole cover No. W4A-1 at the intersection of East Alameda and South Castillo 22 23 Avenue bears South 00° 21' W., 356.00 feet; thence N. 68° 53' W., 253.45 feet to a point marked by a 24 25 P. K. spike in pavement; thence N. 62° 53' W., 36.07

1 feet to a point marked by a 3/4" galvanized iron 2 pipe; thence N. 65° 38' W., 144.00 feet to a point marked by a 3/4" galvanized iron pipe; thence N. 3 58° 08' W., 97.60 feet to a point marked by a 3/4" 4 gal vanized iron pipe; thence N. 66° 37' W., 47.25 feet to a point marked by 3/4" galvanized iron 6 pipe; thence N. 18° 07′ E., 54.25 feet to a point 7 marked by a 3/4" galvanized iron pipe; thence N. 8 9 72° 20' W., 22.60 feet to a point marked by an "X" mark on concrete sidewalk; thence N. 18° 07' E., 10 38.10 feet to a point marked by a 1/2" gal vanized 11 12 iron pipe; thence N. 08° 47' W., 7.30 feet to a point marked by a 3/4" galvanized iron pipe; thence 13 14 N. 16° 20' E., 81.02 feet to a point marked by a 1/2" galvanized iron pipe; thence N. 73° 06' W., 15 66.95 feet to a point marked by a 1/2" gal vanized 16 17 iron pipe; thence N. 18° 24′ E., 30.10 feet to a point marked by a 1/2" galvanized iron pipe; thence 18 N. 71° 49' W., 258.60 feet to a point marked by a 19 20 spike set in brick groove; thence along the easterly side of Cathedral Place N. 15° 52' E., 21 94.20 feet to a point marked by an "X" mark on 22 23 sidewalk; thence along a curve to the right, R =20.07 feet, through an arc length of 31.71 feet to 24 25 the point and place of beginning, the chord of the

said arc running N. 66° 59' E., 28.52 feet; all as shown on that certain plat of survey entitled "PLAT OF SURVEY FOR SISTERS OF CHARITY ST. VINCENT'S HOSPITAL WARD NO. 4 SANTA FE, NEW MEXICO", prepared from a survey completed in the field on October 12, 1973 by George Rivera, Registered Professional Land Surveyor No. 3149;

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WITH WARRANTY COVENANTS.

By acceptance of this deed, the grantee covenants and agrees that the above-described property shall not, at any time prior to October 1, 2001, be used for a use which is competitive with the grantor's use of the facility known as "St. Vincent Hospital" on St. Michael's Drive in Santa Fe, New Mexico, as an acute care hospital.; and

WHEREAS, the property shall not be sold for less than the value of the property established by the taxation and revenue department using generally acceptable appraisal techniques for this type of property and after review by the capitol buildings planning commission; and

WHEREAS, the property control division of the general services department shall act as fiduciary to the capitol buildings planning commission in all matters relative to this

sale;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the proposed sale be hereby ratified and approved pursuant to the provisions of Section 13-6-3 NMSA 1978; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the property control division of the general services department.

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
