Section 1. Section 60-2E-28 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1997,
Chapter 190, Section 30) is amended to read:
"60-2E-28. GAMING OPERATOR LICENSEESSPECIAL CONDITION
FOR NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONSNUMBER OF GAMING MACHINESDAYS
AND HOURS OF OPERATIONS
A. A nonprofit organization may be issued a gaming
operator's license to operate licensed gaming machines on its
premises to be played only by active and auxiliary members.
B. No more than fifteen gaming machines may be
offered for play on the premises of a nonprofit organization
gaming operator licensee.
C. No gaming machine on the premises of a
nonprofit organization gaming operator licensee may award a
