15	Section 1. Section 60-3A-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1981,
16	Chapter 39, Section 3, as amended) is amended to read:
17	"60-3A-3. DEFINITIONSAs used in the Liquor Control
18	Act:
19	A. "alcoholic beverages" means distilled or
20	rectified spirits, potable alcohol, brandy, whiskey, rum, gin
21	and aromatic bitters bearing the federal internal revenue
22	strip stamps or any similar alcoholic beverage, including
23	blended or fermented beverages, dilutions or mixtures of one
24	or more of the foregoing containing more than one-half of one
25	percent alcohol, but excluding medicinal bitters;

"beer" means an alcoholic beverage obtained by 2 the fermentation of any infusion or decoction of barley, malt and hops or other cereals in water, and includes porter, beer, 3 ale and stout; 4 С. "brewer" means a person who owns or operates a 5 business for the manufacture of beer: 6 7 D. "club" means: any nonprofit group, including an 8 (1) auxiliary or subsidiary group, organized and operated under 9 10 the laws of this state, with a membership of not less than 11 fifty members who pay membership dues at the rate of not less 12 than five dollars (\$5.00) per year and who, under the 13 constitution and bylaws of the club, have all voting rights 14 and full membership privileges, and which group is the owner, 15 lessee or occupant of premises used exclusively for club 16 purposes and which group the director finds: 17 (a) is operated solely for recreation, 18 social, patriotic, political, benevolent or athletic purposes; 19 and 20 (b) [the proposed licensee] has been 21 granted an exemption by the United States from the payment of 22 the federal income tax as a club under the provisions of 23 Section 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 24 amended, or, if the applicant has not operated as a club for a 25 sufficient time to be eligible for the income tax exemption, . 139726. 1

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it must execute and file with the director a sworn letter of intent declaring that it will, in good faith, apply for such exemption as soon as it is eligible; or

"commission" means the secretary of public safety when the term is used in reference to the enforcement and investigatory provisions of the Liquor Control Act and means the superintendent of regulation and licensing when the term is used in reference to the licensing provisions of the Liquor Control Act;

"department" means the special investigations F. division of the department of public safety when the term is used in reference to the enforcement and investigatory provisions of the Liquor Control Act and means the director of the alcohol and gaming division of the regulation and licensing department when the term is used in reference to the licensing provisions of the Liquor Control Act;

G. "director" means the director of the special . 139726. 1

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investigations division of the department of public safety when the term is used in reference to the enforcement and investigatory provisions of the Liquor Control Act and means the director of the alcohol and gaming division of the regulation and licensing department when the term is used in reference to the licensing provisions of the Liquor Control Act:

"dispenser" means a person licensed under the H. provisions of the Liquor Control Act selling, offering for sale or having in his possession with the intent to sell alcoholic beverages both by the drink for consumption on the licensed premises and in unbroken packages for consumption and not for resale off the licensed premises:

"distiller" means a person engaged in Ι. manufacturing spirituous liquors;

"golf course" means a tract of land and J. facilities used for playing golf and other recreational activities that includes tees, fairways, greens, hazards, putting greens, driving ranges, recreational facilities, patios, pro shops, cart paths and public and private roads that are located within the tract of land;

K. "governing body" means the board of county commissioners of a county or the city council or city commissioners of a municipality;

L. "hotel" means an establishment or complex

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having a resident of New Mexico as a proprietor or manager and where, in consideration of payment, meals and lodging are regularly furnished to the general public. The establishment or complex must maintain for the use of its guests a minimum of twenty-five sleeping rooms;

M "licensed premises" means the contiguous areas or areas connected by indoor passageways of a structure and the outside dining, recreation and lounge areas of the structure that are under the direct control of the licensee and from which the licensee is authorized to sell, serve or allow the consumption of alcoholic beverages under the provisions of its license; provided that in the case of a restaurant, hotel, golf course or racetrack, "licensed premises" includes all public and private rooms, facilities and areas in which alcoholic beverages are sold or served in the customary operating procedures of the restaurant, hotel, golf course or racetrack;

N. "local option district" means a county that has voted to approve the sale, serving or public consumption of alcoholic beverages, or any incorporated municipality that falls within a county that has voted to approve the sale, serving or public consumption of alcoholic beverages, or any incorporated municipality of over five thousand population that has independently voted to approve the sale, serving or public consumption of alcoholic beverages under the terms of . 139726.1

3 brewer or winer;

4 P. "minor" means a person under twenty-one years
5 of age;

Q. "package" means an immediate container of
al coholic beverages that is filled or packed by a manufacturer
or wine bottler for sale by the manufacturer or wine bottler

S. "rectifier" means a person who blends, mixes or distills alcohol with other liquids or substances for the purpose of making an alcoholic beverage for the purpose of sale other than to the consumer by the drink, and includes all bottlers of spirituous liquors;

<u>T. "resort" means an establishment, having a</u> resident of New Mexico as a proprietor or manager, that: (1) furnishes meals and lodging to the

general public;

(2) maintains for the use of its guests a minimum of one hundred sleeping rooms or recreational vehicle and camping spaces; and

(3) provides at least two resort facilities

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such as facilities for golf, tennis, water sports, horseback riding, skiing, fishing, hunting or sport shooting or is adjacent to or within a national park, monument or forest or state park or monument;

[T.-] <u>U.</u> "restaurant" means an establishment having a New Mexico resident as a proprietor or manager that is held out to the public as a place where meals are prepared and served primarily for on-premises consumption to the general public in consideration of payment and that has a dining room, a kitchen and the employees necessary for preparing, cooking and serving meals; provided that "restaurant" does not include establishments as defined in rules promulgated by the director serving only hamburgers, sandwiches, salads and other fast foods;

[U-] V. "retailer" means a person licensed under the provisions of the Liquor Control Act selling, offering for sale or having in his possession with the intent to sell alcoholic beverages in unbroken packages for consumption and not for resale off the licensed premises;

17	"60-7A-2. SUNDAY SALES AT RACETRACKS <u>AND RESORTS</u>
18	Notwithstanding other provisions of the Liquor Control Act, it
19	is lawful for a dispenser, whose licensed premises are located
20	on a:
21	<u>A.</u> public horseracing track licensed by the state
22	racing commission, to sell, serve or permit the consumption of
23	alcoholic beverages by the drink on Sunday during the racing
24	season between the hours of 12:00 noon and 11:00 p.m.; <u>and</u>
25	<u>B.</u> resort to sell, serve or permit the consumption
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1	<u>of alcoholic beverages by the drink on Sunday from immediately</u>
2	<u>after midnight Saturday until 2:00 a.m. Sunday and from 12:00</u>
3	<u>noon until midnight on Sunday</u> ."
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
