Navajo Nation and Jicarilla Apache Nation residents due to failure of the security system of the computer of the bureau of Indian affairs of the department of the interior. The loan shall be made at the current market rate of interest as stated in *The Wall Street Journal* on the date or in the week the loan is made and shall be paid back within six months from the date of the loan. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2003 shall revert to the general fund.
