AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE BUDGETS; REQUIRING EACH STATE AGENCY, NOT UNDER THE DIRECT CONTROL OF THE GOVERNOR, THAT REQUESTS AN INCREASED APPROPRIATION TO RECOMMEND A REVENUE SOURCE FOR THE ADDITIONAL MONEY REQUESTED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 6-3-18 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1955, Chapter 114, Section 9, as amended by Laws 1999, Chapter 5, Section 10 and also by Laws 1999, Chapter 15, Section 10) is amended to read:

"6-3-18. BUDGET FORMS.--On or before June 15 of each year, the state budget division shall send to each state agency forms that provide for the following information:

A. revenue or anticipated revenue from all sources for the fiscal year last completed, the current fiscal year . 140686.1

1	and [for] the succeeding fiscal year, including [among other
2	things]:
3	(1) grants from the federal government;
4	(2) gifts and grants from private sources;
5	(3) income from investments;
6	(4) proceeds from sale of bonds or other
7	instruments of indebtedness;
8	(5) income from sale of land;
9	(6) income from sale of personal property;
10	(7) income from lease of land or lease of
11	personal property;
12	(8) income from services;
13	(9) income from fees, licenses, fines,
14	penalties, tuition, royalties and other charges;
15	(10) income from athletic activities and
16	related enterprises; and
17	(11) income from each tax collected;
18	B. expenditures or anticipated expenditures for
19	the current fiscal year and for the two succeeding fiscal
20	years, including [among other things]:
21	(1) capital expenditures consisting of:
22	(a) additions to plant or office;
23	(b) repairs and replacements;
24	(c) permanent equipment; and
25	(d) other; and

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1	(2) operational expenditures consisting of:
2	(a) operation and maintenance of
3	institution, office or building;
4	(b) supplies and equipment;
5	(c) personal services;
6	(d) travel; and
7	(e) other;
8	C. [appropriation] <u>appropriations</u> requested for
9	the succeeding fiscal year, with a statement as to the
10	functions and activities of each agency, division and bureau;
11	D. if increased appropriations are requested, the
12	reason therefor <u>and</u> , <u>if the administrative head of the state</u>
13	agency is not appointed by the governor, a recommendation of a
14	revenue source for the additional money requested; and
15	E. citation of statutory authority for functions
16	and activities of the agency, a summary statement as to the
17	workload of the agency and such other information as is
18	specified by the state budget division."
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
