FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN QUEMADO IN CATRON COUNTY.

I request that the following capital outlay projects be funded:

- to the department of environment
 - seventy thousand two hundred dollars (\$70,200) to drill a well and set up a water system at Datil elementary school in the Quemado independent school district in Catron county;
- to the local government division of the department of finance and administration
- fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) to construct improvements to the interior of the emergency training building in Quemado in Catron county; and
- ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) to complete the rodeo arena in Glenwood in Catron county; and
- to the state department of public education
- one hundred twenty-three thousand five hundred dollars (\$123,500) to re-roof Datil elementary school in the Quemado independent school district in Catron county;
- fifty-four thousand seven hundred four dollars (\$54,704) for electrical rewiring at Datil elementary school in the Quemado independent school district in Catron county; and
- seven hundred forty-three thousand six hundred dollars (\$743,600) to plan, design and construct a vocational arts and agriculture building at Quemado high school in the Quemado independent school district in Catron county.
