Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 143 appropriates \$65.0 from the general fund to DOH to expand the women, infants and children (WIC) farmers' market nutrition program.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$65.0 contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY03 shall revert to the general fund.
