

Apache, Jicarilla Apache and Navajo; and (3) the printing of amendments booklets in English and Spanish (including Spanish language translation cost) and distribution to all county clerks (100,000 booklets were printed for 2000 general election). Therefore, there would be a nonrecurring cost to the general fund of \$30.0 in FY03. This legislation does not include an appropriation needed to fund these costs.

ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS

The Secretary of State reports the proliferation of constitutional amendments is having a serious impact on some of New Mexico's counties' voting systems because of ballot crowding.
