2 WHEREAS, for many years, the legislature of New Mexico  
3 was not involved in oversight of Los Alamos national  
4 laboratory, but for the last several years members of the  
5 legislature have been meeting with members of the California  
6 senate committee that provides Los Alamos national laboratory  
7 oversight; and

8 WHEREAS, a committee of the legislature should be  
9 appointed by the New Mexico legislative council to formalize  
10 the New Mexico legislature's commitment to communication with  
11 California regarding oversight of Los Alamos national  
12 laboratory; and

13 WHEREAS, the committee appointed by the New Mexico  
14 legislative council should be directed to appoint members to a  
15 citizens advisory committee, so that the citizens of New  
16 Mexico have a voice in recommending the course of action that  
17 New Mexico legislators should take in oversight and  
18 examination of the activities and consequences of the  
19 activities at Los Alamos national laboratory and in  
20 recommending areas for discussion with the California senate  
21 committee that provides oversight for Los Alamos national  
22 laboratory;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE  
24 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico legislative council be  
25 requested to appoint a joint legislative committee for Los
