WHEREAS, the state board of education has established a strategic goal of ensuring that all students graduate both bilingual and biliterate in recognition of the importance of bilingualism;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that April 30, 2002 be declared "El Dia de los Ninos, Dia de los Libros" to celebrate bilingual literacy and to honor the diverse linguistic and cultural wealth of the state of New Mexico; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that schools, universities, libraries, community groups, museums and the media be encouraged to celebrate the day by engaging in activities that celebrate all languages; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that communities be encouraged to increase their bilingual library collections and to urge their local bookstores to create multilingual book displays; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that parents and family members who speak a language other than English be encouraged to share bilingual stories and games at schools and special events and to engage in other activities that celebrate multilingualism;
