15	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	Section 1. It is proposed to amend Article 7, Section 5
17	of the constitution of New Mexico to read:
18	" <u>A.</u> All elections shall be by ballot [ <del>and</del> ]. The
19	person who receives the highest number of votes for any
20	office, except as provided in Subsection B of this section,
21	and except in the cases of the offices of governor and
22	lieutenant governor, shall be declared elected [ <del>thereto</del> ] <u>to</u>
23	that office. The joint candidates receiving the highest
24	number of votes for the offices of governor and lieutenant
25	governor shall be declared elected to those offices.

1	<u>B. In a municipal election, the candidate who</u>
2	receives the highest number of votes for an office shall be
3	declared elected to that office, unless the municipality
4	provides for runoff elections. A municipality may provide for
