10 A JOINT RESOLUTION

11 PROPOSING TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION OF NEW MEXICO TO PROVIDE  
12 THAT IF A LEGISLATOR HAS INTRODUCED TEN BILLS DURING ANY  
13 SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE, THAT LEGISLATOR SHALL NOT  
14 INTRODUCE ANY ADDITIONAL BILLS UNLESS EACH ADDITIONAL BILL IS  
15 ACCOMPANIED BY ANOTHER BILL, INTRODUCED BY THAT LEGISLATOR, TO  
16 REPEAL AN EXISTING LAW.

18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

19 Section 1. It is proposed to amend Article 4, Section 19  
20 of the constitution of New Mexico to read:

21 "A. Time limitation on the introduction of bills  
22 at any session of the legislature shall be established by law.

23 B. During any session, if a legislator has  
24 introduced ten bills, that legislator shall not introduce any  
25 additional bills unless each additional bill is accompanied by  
another bill, introduced by that legislator, proposing to  
repeal an existing law."

Section 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution  
shall be submitted to the people for their approval or
