WHEREAS, the Explora science center and children's museum is a facility in Albuquerque that serves as an educational resource for school children throughout the state of New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, Explora will be relocating to a new and much larger facility in the museum corridor near the old town of Albuquerque; and

WHEREAS, it is imperative that all school districts in New Mexico be informed about the availability of Explora and how it can be used to enhance and augment science, technology and art instruction; and

WHEREAS, for school districts that are located a significant distance from Albuquerque, procedures need to be developed for overnight visits in the new facility that will allow students to spend the night at Explora's new facility; and

WHEREAS, overnight visits to Explora will also allow school children the time and opportunity to visit other museums that are located near Explora's new facility in the museum corridor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that it request the director of the Explora science center and children's museum and the state department of public education to develop procedures for informing school districts about the availability of Explora as an

educational resource and for assisting school districts with planning overnight visits to Explora; and
