PROCLAIMING WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 12, 2003 AS "SENIOR CITIZEN DAY AT THE LEGISLATURE"; DECLARING LEGISLATIVE SUPPORT FOR SENIOR CITIZEN PROGRAMS AND IN-HOME CARE.

WHEREAS, the legislature has matched federal dollars coming to the state at a rate of three state dollars to one federal dollar; and

WHEREAS, senior citizens engage actively in the legislative process through direct testimony and support of legislation beneficial to them and other New Mexicans; and

WHEREAS, the legislature has long honored the unique tradition of a "citizen legislature" that encourages the involvement of New Mexico residents, including its senior citizens, in the legislative process;
