	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
5	Section 1. GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS FROM FISCAL YEAR 2003
6	LIMITATIONSREVERSIONS
7	A. The general fund appropriations in this act are from fiscal year
8	2003 and may be expended through fiscal year 2008 except as otherwise provided in
9	this section.
10	B. Unless otherwise provided, the unexpended balance of an
11	appropriation made in this act from the general fund, including changes to prior
	appropriations, shall revert to the originating fund as follows:
12	(1) for projects for which appropriations were made to match
13	federal grants, six months after completion of the project;
14	(2) for projects for which appropriations were made to
15	purchase vehicles, heavy equipment, educational technology or equipment or furniture
16	that is not related to a more inclusive construction or renovation project, at the end of
17	the fiscal year following the fiscal year in which the appropriation was made for the
	purchase;
18	(3) for projects for which appropriations were made to
19	purchase emergency vehicles or other vehicles that require special equipment, at the
20	end of the fiscal year two years following the fiscal year in which the severance tax
21	bonds were issued for the purchase; and
22	(4) for all other projects for which appropriations were made,
23	within six months of completion of the project, but no later than the end of fiscal year
24	2008.
	C. Except for appropriations to the capital program fund, money from
25	appropriations made in this act shall not be used to pay indirect project costs.

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1	D. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended balance" means the
2	remainder of an appropriation after reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered
3	by binding written obligations to third parties.

23	Section 18. EMERGENCYIt is necessary for the public peace, health and	
24	safety that this act take effect immediately.
