5	A LOGO FOR ACTIVE DUTY UNIFORM SERVICE MEMBERS.

7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
8	Section 1. A new section of the Motor Vehicle Code,
9	Section 66-3-424 NMSA 1978, is enacted to read:
10	"66-3-424. STANDARDIZED SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES
11	WITH LOGOS
12	A. Standardized special registration plates with
13	logos may be authorized by statute to show state support for
14	worthy public purposes. The authorizing statute shall
15	provide for collection of fees that, at a minimum, will
16	cover the costs to the division of development, manufacture
17	and issuance of the special registration plates and logos.
18	B. Standardized special registration plates, on
19	the standardized areas, shall:
20	(1) display the colors of the state flag,
21	red lettering on a yellow background;
22	(2) display the phrases "New Mexico USA"
23	and "Land of Enchantment";
24	(3) provide a space for applying the
<b>25</b>	special registration logo, centered at the left edge of the

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- (4) provide a vehicle registration number, to be assigned by the division, that consists of five alphanumeric characters displayed to the right of the special logo area.
- C. Special registration logos, except for the standard dimension specified in Paragraph (3) of Subsection B of this section, shall be left to the design discretion of the division, in consultation with the public purpose interest group that requests the special registration plate.
- D. Standardized special registration plates with logos, when authorized by statute for a particular public purpose interest group, shall meet the requirements specified in this subsection prior to plate issuance by the division. The public purpose interest group, no later than the effective date of the authorizing statute:
- (1) shall provide evidence acceptable to the division that it will generate a minimum number of prepaid applications as determined by the division for the special registration plate with logo;
- (2) shall provide a prepayment to the division in an amount sufficient to cover the plate and logo  $${\rm Page}$~2$

- (3) shall provide a sample of the requested artwork design in a format specified by the plate manufacturer for the specialized logo; and
- (4) in cases where the authorizing statute includes revenue sharing with distribution directed to a particular group or fund, shall show that the recipient is a governmental entity or a fund authorized for the use of a governmental entity.
- E. The division may promulgate rules for implementation of the provisions of this section."
- Section 2. A new section of the Motor Vehicle Code, Section 66-3-424.1 NMSA 1978, is enacted to read:
- "66-3-424.1. SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES FOR ACTIVE
  DUTY UNIFORM SERVICE MEMBERS.--
- A. The department shall issue a standardized special registration plate with a logo specified in Section 66-3-424 NMSA 1978 indicating that the recipient is an active duty uniform service member.
- B. For a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), which shall be in addition to the regular motor vehicle registration fees, a motor vehicle owner who is an active duty uniform service member may apply for the issuance of a special registration plate as defined in Subsection A of this section. No two owners shall be issued identically

- D. The revenue from the special active duty
  uniform service member registration plate fee imposed by
  Subsection B of this section shall be distributed as
  follows:

  (1) ten dollars (\$10.00) of the
  fee collected for each registration plate shall be retained
  by the department and is appropriated to the department for
  the manufacture and issuance of the registration plates; and
- (2) fifteen dollars (\$15.00) of the fee collected for each registration plate shall be paid to the state treasurer for credit to the motor vehicle suspense fund for distribution in accordance with Section 66-6-23 NMSA 1978."
- Section 3. Section 66-6-23 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978, Chapter 35, Section 358, as amended) is amended to read:

"66-6-23. DISPOSITION OF FEES. --

A. After the necessary disbursements for refunds and other purposes have been made, the money remaining in  $$^{\rm SB}$\ 197$$_{\rm Page}$\ 4$$ 

- (1) to each municipality, county or fee agent operating a motor vehicle field office:
- (\$6.00) per driver's license and three dollars (\$3.00) per identification card or motor vehicle or motorboat registration or title transaction performed; and
- (b) for each such agent determined by the secretary pursuant to Section 66-2-16 NMSA 1978 to have performed ten thousand or more transactions in the preceding fiscal year, other than a class A county with a population exceeding three hundred thousand or a municipality with a population exceeding three hundred thousand that has been designated as an agent pursuant to Section 66-2-14.1 NMSA 1978, an amount equal to one dollar (\$1.00) in addition to the amount distributed pursuant to Subparagraph (a) of this paragraph for each driver's license, identification card, motor vehicle registration, motorboat registration or title transaction performed;
- (2) to each municipality or county, other than a class A county with a population exceeding three hundred thousand or a municipality with a population

13	license fee collected by the department employees from an

18	(d) an amount equal to fifty percent
19	of the fees collected pursuant to Section 66-6-19 NMSA 1978;

22	Section 66-5-33.1 NMSA 1978 and the remainder of the fees
23	collected pursuant to Subsection A of Section 66-5-408 NMSA

10	amount to be distributed pursuant to Paragraph (2) of
11	Subsection D of Section 66-3-420 NMSA 1978;
12	(9) to the state highway and transportation
13	department, an amount equal to the fees collected pursuant
14	to Section 66-5-35 NMSA 1978;
15	(10) to the state equalization guarantee
16	distribution made annually pursuant to the general
17	appropriation act, an amount equal to one hundred percent of
18	the driver safety fee collected pursuant to Subsection D of
19	Section 66-5-44 NMSA 1978;
20	(11) to the motorcycle training fund, two
21	dollars (\$2.00) of each motorcycle registration fee
22	collected pursuant to Section 66-6-1 NMSA 1978;
23	(12) to the highway infrastructure fund,
24	all tire recycling fees collected pursuant to the provisions

of Sections 66-6-1, 66-6-2, 66-6-4, 66-6-5 and 66-6-8 NMSA

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Z	(13) to each county, an amount equal to
3	fifty percent of the fees collected pursuant to Section
4	66-6-19 NMSA 1978 multiplied by a fraction, the numerator of
5	which is the total mileage of public roads maintained by the
6	county and the denominator of which is the total mileage of
7	public roads maintained by all counties in the state; and

- (14) to the litter control and beautification fund, an amount equal to the fees collected pursuant to Section 66-6-6.2 NMSA 1978.
- B. The balance, exclusive of unidentified remittances, shall be distributed in accordance with Section 66-6-23.1 NMSA 1978.
- C. If any of the paragraphs, subsections or sections referred to in Subsection A of this section are recompiled or otherwise redesignated without a corresponding change to Subsection A of this section, the reference in Subsection A of this section shall be construed to be the recompiled or redesignated paragraph, subsection or section."

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Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. -- Except for Section 1 of this act, the effective date of the provisions of this act is January 1, 2004. The effective date of the provisions of Section 1 of this act is July 1, 2003.

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
