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9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
10	Section 1. A new section of the Motor Vehicle Code,
11	Section 66-3-424 NMSA 1978, is enacted to read:
12	"66-3-424. STANDARDIZED SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES
13	WITH LOGOS
14	A. Standardized special registration plates with
15	logos may be authorized by statute to show state support for
16	worthy public purposes. The authorizing statute shall
17	provide for collection of fees that, at a minimum, will
18	cover the costs to the division of development, manufacture
19	and issuance of the special registration plates and logos.
20	B. Standardized special registration plates, on
21	the standardized areas, shall:
22	(1) display the colors of the state flag,
23	red lettering on a yellow background;
24	(2) display the phrases "New Mexico USA"
25	and "Land of Enchantment";

SB 493 Page 1 (3) provide a space for applying the special registration logo, centered at the left edge of the plate, between the attachment holes, beginning one-fourth inch in from the edge of the plate and having the following dimensions: four and one-eighth inches in height and three and one-eighth inches in width; and

- (4) provide a vehicle registration number, to be assigned by the division, that consists of five alphanumeric characters displayed to the right of the special logo area.
- C. Special registration logos, except for the standard dimension specified in Paragraph (3) of Subsection B of this section, shall be left to the design discretion of the division, in consultation with the public purpose interest group that requests the special registration plate.
- D. Standardized special registration plates with logos, when authorized by statute for a particular public purpose interest group, shall meet the requirements specified in this subsection prior to plate issuance by the division. The public purpose interest group, no later than the effective date of the authorizing statute:
- (1) shall provide evidence acceptable to the division that it will generate a minimum number of prepaid applications as determined by the division for the special registration plate with logo;

1	(2) shall provide a prepayment to the
2	division in an amount sufficient to cover the plate and logo
3	cost of the initial order;
4	(3) shall provide a sample of the requested
5	artwork design in a format specified by the plate
6	manufacturer for the specialized logo; and
7	(4) in cases where the authorizing statute
8	includes revenue-sharing with distribution directed to a
9	particular group or fund, shall show that the recipient is a
10	governmental entity or a fund authorized for the use of a
11	governmental entity.
12	E. The division may promulgate rules for
13	implementation of the provisions of this section."
14	Section 2. A new Section of the Motor Vehicle Code,
15	Section 66-3-424.1 NMSA 1978, is enacted to read:
16	"66-3-424. 1. SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATESNEW MEXICO
17	HIGH SCHOOL RODEO ASSOCIATION
18	A. The division shall issue a standardized
19	special registration plate with a logo specified in Section
20	66-3-424 NMSA 1978 indicating support for the New Mexico
21	high school rodeo association.
22	B. The owner of a motor vehicle may apply for
23	the issuance of a standardized special New Mexico high
24	school rodeo association registration plate with a logo
25	pursuant to the procedures of the division. The owner shall ${\rm Page~3}$

1	pay a fee of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) for initial	
2	issuance and the same fee for each subsequent year in which	
3	he wishes to retain and renew his special plate. The fee is	
4	in addition to regular applicable motor vehicle registration	
5	fees.	
6	C. The revenue from issuance of special New	
7	Mexico high school rodeo association registration plates	
8	shall be distributed as follows:	
9	(1) ten dollars (\$10.00) of the fee	
10	collected for each registration plate shall be retained by	
11	the division and is appropriated to the division for the	
12	manufacture and issuance of the registration plates; and	
13	(2) twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) of the fee	
14	collected for each registration plate shall be distributed	
15	to the New Mexico high school rodeo association to be used	
16	in its scholarship program."	
17	Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATEExcept for Section 1 of
