RELATI NG TO MDTOR VEHI CLES; ENACTING A DESCRIPTION OF AND REQUIREMENTS FOR A STANDARDIZED SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE; providing for a standardized SPECl AL REGI STRATI ON plate with A LOGO FOR THE NEW MEXI CO HI GH SCHOOL RODEO ASSOCI ATI ON; ESTABLI SHI NG A FEE; AMENDI NG AND ENACTI NG SECTI ONS OF THE NMSA 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEG SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. A new section of the Mbtor Vehi cle Code, Section 66-3-424 NMSA 1978, is enacted to read:
" 66-3-424. STANDARDI ZED SPECI AL REG STRATI ON PLATES W TH LOGOS. --
A. Standardized special registration plates with I ogos may be authorized by stat ute to show state support for worthy public purposes. The authorizing stat ute shall provi de for collection of fees that, at a mi mum will cover the costs to the di vi si on of devel opment, manuf acture and issuance of the speci al regi stration pl ates and I ogos.
B. St andardized special regi stration plates, on the standardi zed areas, shall:
(1) display the col ors of the state flag, red lettering on a yellow background;
(2) di spl ay the phrases "New Mexi co USA" and "Land of Enchantment";
(3) provi de a space for appl yi ng the special registration logo, centered at the left edge of the pl ate, bet ween the attachment hol es, begi nni ng one-fourth inch in fromthe edge of the plate and having the following di mensi ons: four and one-ei ghth inches in hei ght and three and one-ei ghth inches in width; and
(4) provi de a vehicle registration number, to be assigned by the division, that consists of five al phanumeric characters di spl ayed to the right of the special Iogo area.
C. Special registration Iogos, except for the standard di mension specified in Paragraph (3) of Subsection B of this section, shall be left to the design di scretion of the division, in consultation with the public purpose interest group that requests the special registration plate.
D. Standardized special registration plates with logos, when authorized by stat ute for a particular public purpose interest group, shall meet the requirements specified in this subsection prior to plate issuance by the di vision. The public purpose interest group, no later than the effective date of the authorizing stat ute:
(1) shall provi de evi dence acceptable to the division that it will generate a min mum number of prepaid applications as determined by the division for the special registration plate with logo;

(2) shall provi de a prepayment to the di vision in an amount sufficient to cover the plate and Iogo cost of the initial order;
(3) shall provide a sample of the requested artwork design in a format specified by the plate manuf acturer for the specialized I ogo; and
(4) in cases where the authorizing statute includes revenue-sharing with di stribution di rected to a particular group or fund, shall show that the reci pient is a governmental entity or a fund authorized for the use of a government al entity.
E. The di vi si on may proml gate rul es for i mplement ation of the provisions of this section."

Section 2. A new Section of the Mbtor Vehi cle Code, Section 66-3-424. 1 NMSA 1978, i s enacted to read:
" 66-3-424. 1. SPECI AL REGI STRATI ON PLATES- - NEW MEXI CO HI GH SCHOOL RODEO ASSOCI ATI ON. - -
A. The di vi si on shall i ssue a standardized special regi stration pl ate with a logo specified in Section 66-3-424 NMSA 1978 indi cating support for the New Mexi co hi gh school rodeo association.
B. The owner of a mot or vehi cle may apply for the i ssuance of a standar di zed special New Mexi co hi gh school rodeo association regi stration plate with a logo pursuant to the procedures of the di vision. The owner shal I

pay a fee of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) for initial issuance and the same fee for each subsequent year in whi ch he wi shes to retai $n$ and renew his special pl ate. The fee is in addition to regul ar applicable mot or vehicle registration f ees.
C. The revenue fromissuance of special New Mexi co hi gh school rodeo associ ation regi stration plates shall be di stributed as follows:
(1) ten dollars (\$10.00) of the fee collected for each regi stration pl ate shall be retai ned by the di visi on and is appropriated to the di vision for the manuf acture and issuance of the regi stration pl ates; and
(2) twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected for each regi stration pl ate shall be di stributed to the New Mexi co hi gh school rodeo associ ation to be used in its schol arshi p program "

Section 3. EFFECTI VE DATE. - Except for Section 1 of this act, the effective date of the provisions of this act is January 1, 2004. The effective date of the provisions of
