10	Section 2. A new section of the Patient Protection Act is enacted to read:

	COMPENSATION
12	A. The superintendent may appoint one or more qualified individuals
13	to review external grievance appeals.
14	B. The superintendent shall fix the reasonable compensation of each
15	appointee based upon, but not limited to, compensation amounts suggested by
16	national or state legal or medical professional societies, organizations or associations.
17	C. Upon completion of the external grievance appeal review, the
18	superintendent shall prepare a detailed statement of compensation due each
	appointee and shall present the statement to the enrollee's health insurer.
19	D. The enrollee's health insurer shall pay the compensation directly to
20	each appointee who participated in the external grievance appeal review.
21	E. The superintendent shall promulgate rules to implement this
22	section."
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
