AN ACT
RELATI NG TO MOTOR VEHI CLES; ENACTING A DESCRIPTION OF AND REQUIREMENTS FOR A STANDARDIZED SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE; PROVIDING FOR A STANDARDIZED SPECI AL REGI STRATI ON PLATE W TH A LOGO FOR SEARCH AND RESCUE MEMBERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEG SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. A new section of the Mbtor Vehi cle Code, Secti on 66-3-424 NMSA 1978, is enacted to read:
" 66-3-424. STANDARDI ZED SPECI AL REG STRATI ON PLATES W TH LOGOS. --
A. Standardized special registration plates with I ogos may be authorized by stat ute to show state support for worthy public purposes. The authorizing stat ute shall provide for collection of fees that, at a mimum will cover the costs to the di vision of devel opment, manufacture and issuance of the speci al registration pl ates and I ogos.
B. St andar di zed special regi stration pl ates, on the standar di zed areas, shall:
(1) di spl ay the col ors of the state flag, red lettering on a yellow background;
(2) di spl ay the phrases "New Mexi co USA" and "Land of Enchantment";
(3) provi de a space for appl ying the special registration logo, centered at the left edge of $t$ he

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pl ate, bet ween the attachment hol es, begi nni ng one-fourth inch in fromthe edge of the plate and having the following di mensi ons: four and one-ei ght $h$ inches in hei ght and three and one-ei ghth inches in widt h; and
(4) provi de a vehicle regi stration number, to be assi gned by the division, that consists of five al phanumeric characters displayed to the right of the special Iogo area.
C. Special registration logos, except for the standard di mension specified in Paragraph (3) of Subsection B of this section, shall be left to the design di scretion of the division, in consultation with the public purpose interest group that requests the special regi stration plate.
D. Standardized special regi stration plates with logos, when authorized by statute for a particular public purpose interest group, shall meet the requirements specified in this subsection prior to plate issuance by the di vision. The public purpose interest group, no later than the effective date of the authorizing stat ute:
(1) shall provi de evi dence acceptable to the division that it will generate a min mumnner of prepaid applications as determined by the division for the special registration plate with logo;
(2) shall provide a prepayment to the di vision in an amount sufficient to cover the plate and logo
cost of the initial order;
(3) shal l provi de a sample of the requested artwork design in a format specified by the plate mænuf acturer for the speci al ized I ogo; and
(4) in cases where the authorizing statute incl udes revenue sharing with distribution directed to a particular group or fund, shall show that the recipient is a gover nment al entity or a fund authorized for the use of a government al entity.
E. The di visi on may proml gate rul es for i mplement ation of the provisions of this section."

Section 2. A new section of the Mbtor Vehi cle Code, Section 66-3-424. 1 NMSA 1978, is enacted to read:
"66-3-424. 1. SPECI AL REGI STRATI ON PLATES FOR SEARCH AND RESCUE MEMBERS. --
A. The department shall i ssue a standardized special registration pl ate with a logo specified in Section 66-3-424 NMSA 1978 indi cating that the reci pi ent is a search and rescue nember.
B. For a fee of twent $y$-five dollars (\$25.00), whi ch shall be in addition to the regul ar mot or vehicle regi stration fees, a motor vehi cle owner who is a search and rescue member may appl y for the issuance of a special regi stration pl ate as defined in Subsection A of this section. No two owners shall be i ssued i dentically lettered PB 549
or number ed pl ates.
C. The twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) fee provi ded in Subsection $B$ of this section shall be wai ved for each regi stration period in whi ch a val idating sticker is issued under the provi si ons of Section 66-3-17 NMSA 1978, in I ieu of the issuance of a special search and rescue member plate.
D. The revenue fromthe special search and rescue member registration pl ate fee imposed by Subsection B of thi s section shall be di stributed as follows:
(1) ten dollars (\$10.00) of the fee collected for each regi stration plate shall be retai ned by the department and is appropriated to the department for the manuf acture and issuance of the regi stration plates; and
(2) fifteen dollars (\$15.00) of the fee collected for each regi stration plate shall be paid to the state treasurer for credit to the motor vehi cle suspense fund for di stribution in accordance with Section 66-6-23 NMSA 1978. "

Section 3. Section 66-6-23 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978, Chapter 35, Section 358, as amended) is amended to read:
"66-6-23. DI SPOSI TI ON OF FEES. --
A. After the necessary di sbursements for ref unds and ot her purposes have been made, the money remai ning in the mot or vehi cle suspense fund, except for remittances
recei ved wi thi $n$ the previ ous two mont hs that are uni dentified as to source or di sposition, shall be di stributed as follows:
(1) to each muni ci pality, county or fee agent operating a mot or vehicle field office:
(a) an amount equal to six dollars (\$6.00) per driver's license and three dollars (\$3.00) per identification card or not or vehicle or mot or boat regi stration or title transaction performed; and
(b) for each such agent determined by the secretary pursuant to Section 66-2-16 NMSA 1978 to have performed ten thousand or more transactions in the preceding fiscal year, ot her than a class A county with a popul ation exceedi ng three hundred thousand or a muni cipality with a popul ation exceeding three hundred thousand that has been desi gnated as an agent pursuant to Section 66-2-14. 1 NMSA 1978, an amount equal to one dollar (\$1.00) in addition to the amount di stributed pursuant to Subparagraph (a) of this paragraph for each driver's license, identification card, not or vehi cle registration, motorboat registration or title transaction performed;
(2) to each muni ci pality or county, ot her than a cl ass A county with a popul ation exceeding three hundred thousand or a muni cipality with a popul ation exceedi ng three hundred thousand desi gnated as an agent
pursuant to Section 66-2-14. 1 NMSA 1978, operating a motor vehi cle field office, an amount equal to fifty cents (\$.50) for each administrative service fee remitted by that county or muni ci pality to the department pursuant to the provisions of Subsection A of Section 66-2-16 NMSA 1978;
(3) to the state road fund:
(a) an amount equal to the fees col lected pursuant to Section 66-7-413. 4 NMSA 1978;
(b) an amount equal to the fee col lected pursuant to Section 66-3-417 NMSA 1978;
(c) the remai nder of each driver's license fee collected by the department empl oyees from an applicant to whoma license is granted after deducting from the driver's license fee the amount of the di stribution aut horized in Paragraph (1) of this subsection with respect to that collected driver's license fee; and
(d) an amount equal to fifty percent of the fees collected pursuant to Section 66-6-19 NMSA 1978;
(4) to the I ocal governments road fund, the amount of the fees collected pursuant to Subsection B of Section 66-5-33. 1 NMSA 1978 and the remai nder of the fees col lected pursuant to Subsection A of Section 66-5-408 NMSA 1978;
(5) to the department:
(a) any amounts rei mbursed to the
department pursuant to Subsection C of Section 66-2-14.1 NMSA 1978;
(b) an amount equal to two dollars (\$2.00) of each motorcycle registration fee collected pursuant to Section 66-6-1 NMEA 1978;
(c) an amount equal to the fees provi ded for in Subsection D of Section 66-2-7 NMSA 1978, Subsection E of Section 66-2-16 NMEA 1978, Subsections J and K of Section 66-3-6 NMSA 1978 other than the administrative fee, Subsection C of Section 66-5-44 NNEA 1978 and Subsection B of Section 66-5-408 NMSA 1978;
(d) the amounts due to the department pursuant to Paragraph (1) of Subsection E of Section 66-3419 NMSA 1978, Subsection E of Section 66- 3-422 NMSA 1978, Subsection E of Section 66-3-423 NMEA 1978 and Paragraph (2) of Subsection D of Section 66-3-424. 1 NMSA 1978; and
(e) an amount equal to the registration fees collected pursuant to Section 66-6-6.1 NMSA 1978 for the purposes of enforcing the provisions of the Mandatory Financial Responsibility Act and for creating and maintai ni ng a multilanguage noncommercial driver's license testing program
(6) to each New Mexi co institution of hi gher education, an amount equal to that part of the fees di stributed pursuant to Paragraph (2) of Subsection D of

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Section 66-3-416 NMSA 1978 proportionate to the number of special registration pl ates issued in the name of the institution to all such special registration pl ates issued in the name of all institutions;
(7) to the armed forces veterans I icense fund, the amount to be di stributed pursuant to Paragraph (2) of Subsection E of Section 66-3-419 NMSA 1978;
(8) to the children's trust fund, the amount to be di stributed pursuant to Paragraph (2) of Subsection D of Section 66-3-420 NMSA 1978;
(9) to the state hi ghway and transportation department, an amount equal to the fees collected pursuant to Section 66-5-35 NMSA 1978;
(10) to the state equal ization guarantee di stribution made annually pursuant to the general appropriation act, an amount equal to one hundred percent of the driver safety fee collected pursuant to Subsection D of Section 66-5-44 NMSA 1978;
(11) to the motorcycle trai ni ng fund, two dollars (\$2.00) of each mot orcycle regi stration fee col lected pursuant to Section 66-6-1 NMSA 1978;
(12) to the hi ghway infrastructure fund, all tire recycling fees collected pursuant to the provisions of Sect ions 66-6-1, 66-6-2, 66-6-4, 66-6-5 and 66-6-8 NMSA 1978;

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(13) to each county, an amount equal to fifty percent of the fees collected pursuant to Section 66-6-19 NMEA 1978 multiplied by a fraction, the numerator of which is the total mileage of public roads mai ntai ned by the county and the denominator of which is the total mileage of public roads maintai ned by all counties in the state; and
(14) to the litter control and beautification fund, an amount equal to the fees collected pursuant to Section 66-6-6. 2 NNEA 1978.
B. The bal ance, excl usive of uni dentified remittances, shall be distributed in accordance with Section 66-6-23. 1 NMSA 1978.
C. If any of the paragraphs, subsections or sections referred to in Subsection A of this section are recompiled or otherwi se redesignated without a corresponding change to Subsection $A$ of this section, the reference in Subsection $A$ of this section shall be construed to be the recompiled or redesi gnated paragraph, subsection or section. "

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Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. -- Except for Section 1 of this act, the effective date of the provisions of this act is January 1, 2004. The effective date of the provisions of Section 1 of this act is July 1, 2003.
