10	A. A seed cotton module transport vehicle may transport loads without	
11	securing a permit or escort if:	
	(1) the vehicle is:	
12	(a) no wider than nine feet;	
13	(b) no longer than forty-eight feet; and	
14	(c) no higher than fourteen feet six inches;	
15	(2) the load is not transported for a distance greater than one	
16	hundred miles;	
17	(3) the gross vehicle weight of the vehicle is less than fifty-nine	
18	thousand four hundred pounds;	
	(4) the vehicle is marked on the front and the rear with	
19	"OVERSIZED LOAD" signs; and	
20	(5) the vehicle is not operated on highways for which a more	
21	strict size or weight limitation is required by federal law.	
22	B. If the owner of a seed cotton module transport vehicle transports a
