5	Section 1. A new section of the Environmental Improvement Act is enacted to

7	"WATER RECREATION FACILITIES FUNDCREATEDFEE IMPOSITION
8	PURPOSE
9	A. The "water recreation facilities fund" is created in the state treasury
10	to be used to administer and enforce rules pertaining to public swimming pools, public
11	spas and other public water recreation facilities. All fees collected pursuant to
	Subsection B of this section shall be deposited in the fund. Money in the fund shall
12	not be transferred to any other fund. Disbursements from the fund shall be drawn on
13	warrant of the secretary of finance and administration upon vouchers signed by the
14	secretary of environment or his authorized representative.
15	B. The environmental improvement board may assess an annual fee
16	not to exceed one hundred fifty dollars (\$150) on the owner or operator of a public
17	swimming pool, public spa or other public water recreation facility to defray the cost of
18	administering and enforcing rules adopted in accordance with the Environmental
	Improvement Act pertaining to public water recreation facilities. The fee shall be
19	based on the
20	size of the public water recreation facility."
