- C. The committee shall conduct open meetings as needed, but not less than quarterly.
- D. The department of environment shall provide technical and legal assistance to the committee as needed.
 - E. The committee shall:
- establish procedures, practices and policies governing the committee's activities;
- provi de standardi zed objecti ve **(2)** evaluation of wastewater treatment and disposal technologies for both large- and small-flow domestic, commercial and agricultural wastewater systems and submit its findings to the secretary for final approval by the secretary, who shall add the wastewater treatment and disposal technologies to the list of approved technologies maintained by the department, including the ground water quality bureau and the liquid waste program of the field operations division of the department of environment and their constituent agencies; and
