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- В. A fiscal intermediary may identify a personal care attendant as a covered employee with the fiscal intermediary's workers' compensation carrier solely to provide workers' compensation coverage in the event of a work-related injury. Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to create an employer-employee relationship between the fiscal intermediary and the personal care attendant.
- C. Nothing in this section shall be construed to provide the fiscal intermediary with immunity from a claim for a wrongful act committed by the fiscal intermediary or its employees.

D. As used in this section:

- (1) "consumer" means a person who is eligible for and receives state-funded or -operated services based on the person's disabilities;
- "fiscal intermediary" means a provider **(2)** that furnishes administrative assistance for a consumer who selects a consumer-directed, rather than consumer-delegated, personal care program;
