1	A JOINT MEMORIAL
2	REQUESTING THE NEW MEXICO LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL TO CONTINUE THE
3	JUDICIAL SYSTEM STUDY COMMITTEE.
4	WHEREAS, until the 2001 interim, the legislature had not studied the judiciary
5	as an administrative system for thirty years; and
6	WHEREAS, this lack of concentrated review has led to a piecemeal approach
7	to systematic problems, and each year numerous, often conflicting, bills are introduced
8	into the legislature to address singular parts of the system; and
9	WHEREAS, when the judicial system study committee was created by the New
10	Mexico legislative council in June 2001, the committee recognized that a thorough
11	judicial system study would take more than one or two interims; and
	WHEREAS, one critical area of study for the committee next interim is the
12	continuation of its study of the judicial retirement systems and their funding sources
13	and actuarial soundness;
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
15	STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico legislative council be requested to
16	continue the judicial system study committee during the 2003 interim; and
17	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the
18	New Mexico legislative council.
