	WHEREAS, New Mexico has a long and distinguished history in scientific	г а
5	research, including in the fields of astronomy and space science, and continues the	g e
6	tradition as a state where much cutting-edge scientific research is conducted; and	1
7	WHEREAS, astronomer Alan Hale, a native of Alamogordo, New Mexico, a	ı
8	resident of Cloudcroft, New Mexico and director of the southwest institute for space	
9	research, co-discovered comet Hale-Bopp in 1995, which generated much public	
10	interest when it appeared in the nighttime skies two years later; and	
11	WHEREAS, in response to numerous "controversies" surrounding the comet at	
	the time of its appearance, Hale stressed the importance of science education and of	
12	scientists diligently working toward alleviating scientific illiteracy; and	
13	WHEREAS, Hale urges everyone to look at the "wonders of the universe" and	
14	to use the inspiration they thereby receive to confront the many challenges facing our	
15	society today; and	
16	WHEREAS, in that spirit, Hale led two delegations of Americans on "science	
17	diplomacy" expeditions to Iran and thus utilized astronomy as a tool to foster improved	
18	relations with the citizens of that nation; and	
19	WHEREAS, Hale also journeyed to Zimbabwe and, through astronomy, has	
	had the opportunity to issue comforting and encouraging statements in support of the	
20	citizens of that nation; and	
21	WHEREAS, inspired by these and other similar experiences, Hale developed	
22	the Earthrise project in 2002 to inspire and encourage the next generation of students	
23	around the world to collaborate in efforts to investigate the mysteries of the universe;	
24		
25	WHEREAS, Earthrise takes its name from the images of Earth taken by the	
	Apollo astronauts, which reveal Earth as "a small jewel in space with no political

2	WHEREAS, Earthrise founders hope that participants will learn to "share in	J M
3	their common humanity and grow up to see their counterparts in other countries as	7
4	friends and colleagues";	2 P
