4	WHEREAS, each year thousands of abused and neglected children are taken
	into protective custody by the children, youth and families department; and
5	WHEREAS, each year the state's judicial system determines that it is not in the
6	best interest of approximately three hundred of those abused and neglected children
7	to be returned to their families of origin; and
8	WHEREAS, the children, youth and families department is charged with finding
9	adoptive homes for abused and neglected children; and
10	WHEREAS, from 1995 through 2002, due to the dedication and awareness-
	raising efforts of the children, youth and families department, one thousand nine
11	hundred twenty-seven New Mexico children were adopted; and
12	WHEREAS, the number of children, youth and families department adoptive
13	placements annually increased one hundred thirty-seven percent between 1995 and
14	2002; and
15	WHEREAS, although that increase in adoptions represents substantial
16	progress, there are still many New Mexico children who need permanent and loving
17	homes; and
	WHEREAS, the children, youth and families department continues to strive to
18	raise public and legislative awareness about the need for homes for many of New
19	Mexico's children who await adoption; and
20	WHEREAS, on February 21, 2003, staff members of the children, youth and
21	families department and New Mexico children from around the state who need adoptive
22	homes, along with their foster parents, will be present at the state capitol in order to
23	raise awareness among the legislators about the crucial need for adoptive homes;
24	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
	STATE OF NEW MEXICO that February 21, 2003 be designated "Adoption Day at the
25	Legislature"; and
