9	contributions to American society economically, culturally and politically; and	
10	WHEREAS, Italian Americans have won prestigious prizes, such as the Nobel	
11	prize, the Pritzker award for architecture and the Fields medal for mathematics; and	
	WHEREAS, Italians and Italian Americans invented pianos, violins, calendars,	
12	radios, telescopes, compasses, microscopes, thermometers, eyeglasses, steam	
13	engines, typewriters and batteries; and	
14	WHEREAS, a great many Americans have enjoyed the entertainment provided	
15	by Italian Americans, such as hall of fame baseball player Joe DiMaggio, singer and	
16	songwriter Frank Sinatra, world-renowned composer Henry Mancini and Oscar-winning	
17	actor Robert DeNiro; and	
18	WHEREAS, great Italian American political figures, such as Fiorella La	
	Guardia, who was both mayor of, then congressman from, New York City; Anthony	
19	Celebrezze who, in the Kennedy administration, was the first Italian American cabinet	
20	member; and Antonin Scalia who, in 1982, became the first Italian American supreme	
21	court justice, have enriched the political process and brought national pride to our	
22	country; and	
23	WHEREAS, Senator Pete Domenici is not only the longest serving Italian	
24	American senator ever to serve in the United States senate, but he is also the longest-	
25	serving New Mexico senator; and	
40	WHEREAS, over five million four hundred thousand Italians immigrated to the	

1	United States between 1820 and 1991, which has resulted in there being over twenty-	S
2	six million Americans of Italian descent in the United States today, making them the	J M
3	fifth-largest ethnic group; and	7
4	WHEREAS, in New Mexico, during the early part of that immigration period,	5 P
	many Italian immigrants worked in the mining industry and were instrumental in its	а

6	WHEREAS, New Mexico's history and diversity have been greatly enriched by	2
7	the participation of its Italian American citizens; and	
8	WHEREAS, there have been and continue to be outstanding contributions to	
9	the politics, culture and economy of	
10	New Mexico by its Italian American population;	
11	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE	
12	STATE OF NEW MEXICO that March 11, 2003 be designated as "Italian American	
13	Day" at the legislature in recognition of the contributions of Italian Americans, including	
	our own United States Senator Pete Domenici, to the greatness of our state; and
