S A JOINT MEMORIAL 1 J REQUESTING LICENSING AUTHORITIES TO REEXAMINE CONTINUING EDUCATION 2 Μ REQUIREMENTS FOR THOSE LICENSEES CALLED TO ACTIVE MILITARY DUTY. 3 8 2 4 Ρ WHEREAS, thousands of dedicated, earnest and patriotic New Mexicans are а 5 g members of the New Mexico national guard and the armed forces reserves; and е 6 WHEREAS, hundreds of those New Mexicans have been or will be called to 1 7 leave their families, jobs and homes to do their part in protecting their country in the war on terror; and 8 WHEREAS, in performing that duty, New Mexicans who in their civilian lives are 9 required to meet certain requirements, such as a minimum number of hours of 10 continuing education, to maintain professional and occupational licenses will be hard 11 pressed to meet those requirements; and 12 WHEREAS, many New Mexicans called to duty will be performing similar skills 13 as they perform in civilian life and subject to similar professional supervision and 14 quality assurance as they are in civilian life; and WHEREAS, while some professional and occupational licensure requirements 15 are set in law and cannot be waived, many others are set by regulation; 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE 17 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the various boards, commissions and other authorities 18 with the power to waive certain licensure requirements be requested to do so for those 19 New Mexicans who are members of the New Mexico national guard and the armed 20 forces reserves who are called to duty; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the 21 regulation and licensing department and the various boards, commissions and 22 authorities that grant professional or occupational licenses. 23 24 25
