5	WHEREAS, New Mexico has a long association with wild horses, many of them	g e
6	descending from the Spanish colonial horses brought to North America five hundred	-
7	years ago; and	1
8	WHEREAS, the first horse race ever recorded on American soil was held near	
9	Bernalillo in 1541; and	
10	WHEREAS, congress enacted the Wild Free-Roaming Horses and Burros Act	
11	in 1971, providing for the protection, management and control of wild horses and	
	burros on public land, under the auspices of the United States department of the	
12	interior and department of agriculture; and	
13	WHEREAS, the only federally recognized wild free-roaming horses in New	
14	Mexico are found west of Dulce in the Carson national forest, on La Jarita mesa near	
15	Ojo Caliente and in the bureau of land management's Bonito Atravesado wild horse	
16	area east of Socorro; and	
17	WHEREAS, the bureau of land management showed a count of only seventy	
18	horses in New Mexico in 2000; and	
19	WHEREAS, there are numerous bands of wild horses throughout New Mexico,	
	not included in this count, that have been verified by local residents as wild and not	
20	strays; and	
21	WHEREAS, because most of New Mexico's wild horses have no protection,	
22	they are being rounded up, auctioned and slaughtered at the rate of thousands per	
23	year; and	
24	WHEREAS, these wild horses by their very nature roam across lands	
25	belonging to the state and federal governments, sovereign Indian lands and private	
	land, which creates jurisdictional issues; and	

1	WHEREAS, these unclaimed and unprotected horses belong to the people of	S
2	New Mexico and are part of our living history;	J M
3	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE	9
4	STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the appropriate interim legislative committee be	6 P
	requested to study ways to save the wild horses of New Mexico from extinction and that	a
5	the committee work in cooperation with the bureau of land management, appropriate	g e
6	state agencies, tribal governments and wild horse advocacy groups; and	2
7	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee report its findings to the	-
8	legislature by the second session of the forty-sixth legislature; and	
9	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the	
10	New Mexico legislative council, the bureau of land management, appropriate state	
11	agencies, tribal governments and wild horse advocacy groups.
