9	schools and face possible sanctions if adequate progress does not occur for a period	
10	of consecutive years; and	
11	WHEREAS, research indicates a strong relationship between the quality of	
12	teaching in a school and student academic performance; and	
	WHEREAS, the following strategies are proposed as a means to focus on	
13	issues of teacher quality and student needs in order to improve student academic	
14	performance in probationary schools:	
15	A. providing extended contracts for school personnel for an eight-hour	
16	day;	
17	B. employing for the participating elementary schools only those	
18	teachers who are fully certified in the field in which they teach, provided that transfers	
19	of teachers who have substandard or substitute certificates or are teaching on subject	
	waivers to other schools shall be in accordance with the due process provisions of	
20	Chapter 22, Article 10 NMSA 1978;	
21	C. providing a rigorous evaluation, mentorship and intervention	
22	program for teachers who choose to remain at the pilot project elementary schools;	
23	D. constituting a school personnel committee, consisting of a	
24	curriculum coordinator, six teachers and four parents, that develops criteria for	
25	selecting teacher candidates to fill vacancies and make recommendations to the	
-0	principal on teacher candidates;	

1	E. requiring the principal to employ new teachers from a list of three	S
2	candidates recommended by the school personnel committee;	J M
3	F. providing after-school activities and tutoring services for the	9
4	elementary school's students;	9 P
	G. providing full-day and full-year pre-kindergarten and kindergarten	а

6	H. providing a five percent salary increase for teachers in the	2
7	elementary school above any other salary increase approved by the local school	2
8	board; and	
9	I. providing an additional ten thousand dollar (\$10,000) annual salary	
10	differential above the local school board salary for each teacher who is certified by the	
11	national board for professional teaching standards;	
	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE	
12	STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the state department of public education be requested	
13	to identify three probationary public elementary schools that are willing to enter into a	
14	five-year pilot project to implement the strategies listed in this memorial with the goal of	
15	improving student performance and being removed from the list of probationary	
16	schools; and	
17	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the department work with the selected public	
18	schools and their school districts to identify all possible sources of state and federal	
19	funds to address additional costs associated with the pilot project; and	
	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the department provide priority to the pilot	
20	project schools in awarding any state, federal or private grants available, as allowable	
21	within federal and state laws and guidelines; and	
22	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the department and the pilot schools report	
23	annually to the legislative education study committee on student progress in these	
24	pilot schools based on the statewide accountability system required by state and	
25	federal law; and	
	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the
