AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMINAL LAW; PRESCRIBING CRIMINAL PENALTIES FOR DESTRUCTION OF A LETTER BOX.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. DESTRUCTION OF A LETTER BOX. --

A. Destruction of a letter box consists of intentionally and without the consent of the owner:

- (1) tearing down, taking, damaging or destroying a letter box; or
 - (2) breaking open a letter box.
- B. Whoever commits destruction of a letter box is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be sentenced pursuant to the provisions of Section 31-19-1 NMSA 1978.
- C. As used in this section, "letter box" means any mail receptacle intended or used, by the United States postal

service or postal customers, for the receipt or delivery of mail on a mail route.

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2003.
