## AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION TO EXTEND A PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT NETWORK OF NEW MEXICO SECONDARY SCHOOL ENGLISH TEACHERS TO IMPROVE THE READING. LITERACY AND TECHNOLOGY SKILLS OF THEIR STUDENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT NETWORK OF ENGLISH TEACHERS--APPROPRIATION. --

A. Two hundred forty-three thousand five hundred dollars (\$243,500) is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal years 2003 and 2004 for the purpose of extending a professional development network of New Mexico secondary school English teachers to improve the reading, literacy and technology skills of their students. The network shall:
