AN ACT

RELATING TO DAYS OF SPECIAL OBSERVANCE; CHANGING THE HISPANIC CULTURE DAY OBSERVANCE TO ODD-NUMBERED YEARS; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE NMSA 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 12-5-13 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2001, Chapter 193, Section 1) is amended to read:

"12-5-13. HISPANIC CULTURE DAY.--The second Tuesday of February of each <u>odd-numbered</u> year shall be known and celebrated as "Hispanic culture day" in recognition of the many contributions, sacrifices and accomplishments of Hispanic people from throughout the world [that] who have built New Mexico into a beautiful and dynamic mosaic of cultural diversity. This day shall be observed with celebrations that honor all past, present and future Hispanic citizens and
