Section 2. A new section of the Teacher Loan for Service Act is enacted to read:

"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] FUND CREATED.--The "teacher loan payment fund" is created in the state treasury to pay student loans for qualifying teachers. The fund includes gifts, grants and donations. Money in the fund shall not revert at the end of a fiscal year. The fund shall be administered by the commission and money in the fund is appropriated to the commission to carry out the purposes of the fund. Disbursements from the fund shall be made on warrants drawn by the secretary of finance and administration pursuant to vouchers signed by the executive director of the commission or the designated representative of the executive director."

Section 3. APPROPRIATION. --Six hundred forty-two thousand dollars (\$642,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the teacher loan payment fund for expenditure in fiscal year 2004 and subsequent fiscal years to carry out the provisions of the Teacher Loan for Service Act. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of a fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund.
