19	DIVISION POWER TO CLOSE CERTAIN HIGHWAYS IN EMERGENCIES
20	Notwithstanding any rule [regulation] or agreement of the state
21	highway and transportation department, the New Mexico state
22	police <u>or motor transportation division of the department of</u>
23	public safety, in cases of emergency where the condition of a
24	state highway presents a substantial danger to vehicular travel
25	by reason of storm, fire, accident, spillage of hazardous
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		1	materials or other unusual or dangerous conditions, may close
		2	[such] <u>the</u> highway to vehicular travel until the New Mexico
		3	state police <u>or the motor transportation division of the</u>
		4	<u>department of public safety</u> determines otherwise. The state
		5	highway and transportation department shall be notified of the
		6	highway closure as soon as practicable."
		7	Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATEThe effective date of the
