## AN ACT

RELATI NG TO CRI M NAL LAW I NCREASI NG THE DOLLAR AMOUNT FOR WRI TI NG A BAD CHECK BEFORE IT BECOMES A FELONY OFFENSE; AMENDI NG A SECTI ON OF THE NMEA 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEG SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. Section 30-36-5 NMSA 1978 (bei ng Laws 1965, Chapter 114, Section 1) is amended to read:
" 30-36-5. PENALTY. - - [Any] A person [ violating] who vi ol ates Section [ 40-49-4 New Mexico Statutes Annotated, 1953 Compilation] 30-36-4 NMSA 1978 shall be puni shed as follows:
A. when the amount of the check, draft or order or the total amount of the checks, drafts or orders [are] is for more than one dollar ( $\$ 1.00$ ) but less than [ty-five-dollars $(\$ 25.00)]$ two hundred fifty dollars $(\$ 250)$, the person shall be sentenced to imprisonment in the county jail for a termof not . 144016. 1
more than thirty days or a fine of not more than one hundred dollars (\$100), or both [such imprisonment and fine]; or
B. when the amount of $t$ he check, draft or order or the total amount of the checks, drafts or orders [are] is for [twenty five dollars (\$25.00)] two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) or more, the person shall be sentenced to imprisonment in the penitentiary for a term of not less than one year [ nof] or more than three years or the payment of a fine of not more than one thousand dollars ( $\$ 1,000$ ), or both [such imprisonment and fine]."

Section 2. EFFECTI VE DATE. -- The ef fective date of the provi si ons of this act is July 1, 2003.
