## AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO ASSIST NEW MEXICANS WITH DISABILITIES TO BECOME HOMEOWNERS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

## Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. Two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the department of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal year 2004 in the following amounts for the following purposes:

- (1) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for a down payment assistance revolving loan fund to enable individuals with disabilities to achieve home ownership; and
- (2) one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for technical assistance necessary for persons with disabilities to achieve home ownership, including:

- B. Pursuant to the Joint Powers Agreements Act and Subsection G of Section 58-18-5.5 NMSA 1978, the department of finance and administration shall enter into a joint powers agreement with the New Mexico mortgage finance authority under which the authority shall carry out the purposes of the appropriation.
- C. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2004 shall revert to the general fund.
