APPROPRIATION. -- Two hundred sixty thousand Section 1. dollars (\$260,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the commission on higher education for expenditure in fiscal year 2004 to provide a program that trains middle school teachers to improve their skills, technical knowledge and teaching techniques in science, mathematics and technology so that they are better prepared to teach students in those subjects. unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2004 shall revert to the general fund.
