RELATING TO CRIMINAL LAW: TOLLING THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS FOR CERTAIN PROSECUTIONS REGARDING CRIMINAL SEXUAL PENETRATION; ENACTING A NEW SECTION OF CHAPTER 30, ARTICLE 1 NMSA 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of Chapter 30, Article 1 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] CRIMINAL SEXUAL PENETRATION--TOLLING OF STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS. --

When DNA evidence is available and a suspect has not been identified, the applicable time period for commencing a prosecution pursuant to Section 30-1-8 NMSA 1978 shall not commence to run for an alleged violation of Subsection D, E or F of Section 30-9-11 NMSA 1978 until a DNA profile is matched with a suspect.
