The state engineer shall adopt rules for priority administration to ensure that authority is exercised: 2 3 so as not to interfere with a future or (1) 4 pending adjudication; 5 (2) so as to create no impairment of water rights, other than what is required to enforce priorities; and 6 7 (3) so as to create no increased depletions. 8 C. The state engineer shall adopt rules based on 9 the appropriate hydrologic models to promote expedited 10 marketing and leasing of water in those areas affected by 11 priority administration. 12 D. Nothing in this section shall affect the partial 13 final decree and settlement agreement as may be entered in the 14 Carlsbad irrigation district project offer phase of State of 15 New Mexico ex rel.
