16	Section 1. A new section of Chapter 66, Article 3 NMSA

19	MEXICO MEMBER OF THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE
20	A. The department shall issue special registration
21	plates to a person who is a New Mexico member of the fraternal
22	order of police.
23	B. No person shall represent himself to be a New
24	Mexico member of the fraternal order of police if he is, in
25	fact, not a New Mexico member of the fraternal order of police.

The secretary shall determine what constitutes satisfactory proof.

C. A person who violates the provisions of
Subsection B of this section is guilty of a petty misdemeanor
and shall be sentenced pursuant to Section 31-19-1 NMSA 1978.

D. A fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), which shall be in addition to the regular motor vehicle registration fee, shall be collected by the department for the original issuance of the special registration plate for a New Mexico member of the fraternal order of police.

E. Ten dollars (\$10.00) of the fee collected pursuant to Subsection D of this section shall be retained by the department and is appropriated to the department to defray the cost of making and issuing special registration plates for a New Mexico member of the fraternal order of police.

F. The amount of the fee collected pursuant to this section less any amount distributed pursuant to Subsection E of this section shall be deposited in the motor vehicle suspense fund for distribution in accordance with Section 66-6-23 NMSA 1978.

G. The secretary shall approve the final plate design for the special registration plates for New Mexico members of the fraternal order of police.

H. When a person holding a special plate ceases to be a New Mexico member of the fraternal order of police, he .143626.1 -2-
