AN ACT

**MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO SUPPORT PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS
TO DEVELOP AFTER-SCHOOL AND OTHER PREVENTION PROGRAMS FOR THE
YOUTH OF NEW MEXICO; PROVIDING FOR FUND DISTRIBUTION.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

**Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Two hundred fifty thousand
dollars (\$250,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
department of finance and administration for expenditure in
fiscal year 2004 for the purpose of providing matching funds to
support community-based after-school and other prevention
services and programs for youth. The department of finance and
administration shall award fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000)
each to the state department of public education, the children,
youth and families department, the department of health, the
human services department and the labor department when the**

1 respective departments demonstrate to the department of finance
2 and administration that matching funds are available and
3 committed to provide services for youth. Any unexpended or
4 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2004
