16	Section 1. A new section of Chapter 3, Article 19 NMSA

19	REVIEWOnce a development application has been accepted for
20	review, the application shall be reviewed based on the master
21	plan or subdivision ordinance that existed at the time the

23	municipality. The application shall be subject to proposed
24	ordinances subsequently adopted by the governing body that were

Section 2. A new section of Chapter 3, Article 20 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:

"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] SUBDIVISION APPROVALS--APPLICATIONS--STANDARD OF REVIEW.--Once an application for the subdivision of land has been accepted for review, the application shall be reviewed based on the master plan or subdivision ordinance that existed at the time the subdivision application was accepted for review."

Section 3. A new section of the New Mexico Subdivision Act is enacted to read:

"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] PRELIMINARY AND FINAL PLAT APPROVALS--STANDARD OF REVIEW.--An application for final plat approval shall be reviewed based on the subdivision regulations that existed at the time the application for final plat approval was accepted for review by the county."

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2003.
